



## Teachers Resources - Sustainability – Our Place – Answers and suggestions

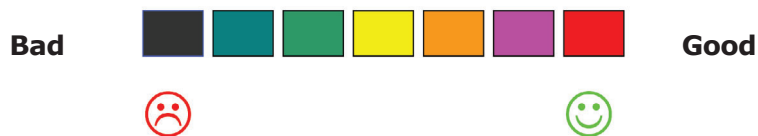
### Age 10-11 Activity 1 Environmental Project

Ask the children to think of a street they know, they live on or where a relative lives and ask them to think about the street/road over the duration of one week and consider the following questions:

#### Audit Questions

1. Is there litter on the street?
2. Are walls and doors covered with graffiti?
3. What condition is street furniture in e.g. bins, benches, and lamposts?
4. Are the pedestrian signpost in a suitable location?
5. Are there any bin-bags out on the street?
6. Is there any public art or a monument within the street?
7. What is the condition of bus shelters? Are they clean or grubby?
8. Are there areas of green space e.g. park, grassed areas?
9. Are there any play areas?
10. How many pieces of play equipment are there?
11. How many trees are on the street?
12. Do shop fronts look new and attractive or old and faded?
13. Do any ponds or pools have fish, frogs and insects in them?
14. Is the street clean or dusty with lots of litter leaves and dirt?

Using the scale below, show how this street makes you feel?



### Age 10-11 Activity 2 – Your Community

Ask the children to design a community where they would like to live, they could consider the following items which could include:

- School
- Leisure
- Green spaces
- Place/places to pray/worship
- Places to work
- Council building
- Roads/street/footpaths
- Cycle paths
- Shops
- Bus stops
- Any other buildings/services they feel would make a good community
